Dear Mr. Wright and Mr. Bridgewater:

This project is discharging significant amounts of sediment in its stormwater from its LOD. We are requesting an immediate inspection and work stoppage until the correct controls are in place and effectively stopping sediment discharge from the LOD.

This site discharges into Evitts Run which then discharges into the Shenandoah River. The sedimentation in the discharge from the site is so significant that it can be seen plainly in the Shenandoah River. Please find attached photos taken Sunday, September 24. The first is of Evitts Run; the second set is of where Evitts Run joins the Shenandoah River; and the third is a map denoting where the pictures were taken.

We ask that (1) an immediate unannounced inspection be performed and (2) that a work stoppage be required until appropriate and effective stormwater controls are installed.
